An Update of the Progress of Business Liaison Groups

Purpose

This paper provides an update of the overall work progress of the ten Business Liaison Groups (BLGs) since the last meeting of the Task Force on Business Liaison Groups (BLGTF) held on 20 April 2021.

Progress

- 2. From 20 April to 27 July 2021, one BLG meeting was held and a total of five issues were satisfactorily resolved or clarified. At the meeting, four information dissemination sessions on business facilitation were conducted by the departments concerned. A breakdown of these figures by the BLGs is shown at *Appendix*. During the pandemic period, we have continued to maintain communication with the trades through various means to gauge their concerns and follow them up by coordinating with relevant government departments. BLGTF Papers 122 to 124 set out some latest business facilitation measures that will benefit BLG trades and address their concerns.
- 3. The Secretariat will continue to provide advance notice to members once the schedule for future BLG meetings is available so that members can attend the BLG meetings as observers.
