Business Facilitation Advisory Committee Task Force on Business Liaison Groups

An Update of the Progress of Business Liaison Groups

Purpose

This paper provides an update of the overall work progress of the ten Business Liaison Groups (BLGs) since the last meeting of the Task Force on Business Liaison Groups (BLGTF) held on 30 December 2022.

Progress

- 2. From 17 December 2022 to 18 April 2023, we have conducted three BLG meetings and proactively liaised with the trade of six BLGs. A total of 18 issues were satisfactorily resolved or clarified and seven information dissemination sessions on business facilitation measures, relaxation of regulatory requirements and e-services for licence applications were conducted by the relevant departments as arranged by the Secretariat. A breakdown of these figures by the BLGs is shown at *Appendix*. BLGTF Papers 138 and 139 set out details of the e-services for application for Permit to Use and Operate Amusement Ride, and the application for Feed-in Tariff Scheme and installation of solar photovoltaic system respectively, which benefit a large variety of trades related to the BLGs.
- 3. To enhance communication with the trade, the Secretariat continues the provision of various channels including an online form for the trade to share their views on licensing application and regulatory regime, and the uploading of summaries on the views collected and the Government responses onto the Business Facilitation Initiatives website on a regular basis. Salient examples are presented in the 33rd meeting of the BLGTF.
- 4. The Secretariat will provide advance notice to members once the schedule for future BLG meetings is available so that members can attend the BLG meetings as observers.
