Proposed Updates to Safety Standards for Toys and Children's Products

The Government proposes adopting up-to-date safety standards promulgated by the relevant standards institutions for toys and some children's products listed in Schedule 2 ("Schedule 2 products") under the Toys and Children's Products Safety Ordinance (Cap. 424) ("the Ordinance"). We are seeking comments on the proposal.

- 2. The Ordinance stipulates that a person must not manufacture, import or supply a toy or Schedule 2 product unless it complies with all the applicable requirements contained in any one of the safety standards (international standards or standards adopted by major economies) specified in Schedules 1 and 2 respectively to the Ordinance. We keep in view updates to the standards so as to apply up-to-date, operative versions to products supplied in Hong Kong.
- 3. It has come to our attention that the specified standards for toys and for three classes of Schedule 2 products have been updated/amended to new versions as follows -

Toy Standards –

- the existing part of the International Standard, "IEC 62115 Edition 1.2 (2011-02) [IEC 62115 Edition 1:2003 consolidated with amendment 1:2004 and amendment 2:2010]" has been updated to "IEC 62115:2017 Edition 2.0";
- (b) the existing part of the European Standard "BS EN 71-12:2013" has been updated to "BS EN 71-12:2016"; and
- (c) the existing part of the ASTM Standard "ASTM F963-11" has been updated to "ASTM F963-17".

Schedule 2 Product Standards –

- (a) the existing ASTM Standard "ASTM F963-11" for *babies'* dummies has been updated to "ASTM F963-17";
- (b) the existing ASTM Standard "ASTM F404-16a" for *children's* high chairs and multi-purpose high chairs for domestic use has been updated to "ASTM F404-17";

- (c) the existing ASTM Standard "ASTM F963-11" for *children's* paints has been updated to "ASTM F963-17"; and
- (d) the existing Joint Australian/New Zealand Standard "AS/NZS ISO 8124.3:2012" for *children's paints* has been updated to "AS/NZS ISO 8124.3:2012 / Amendment 1:2016".
- 4. The table attached at the <u>Annex</u> to this document summarises the major changes introduced by the latest standards^{Note}.
