### **Programme Overview**

The Government is embarking on an e-Procurement Pilot Programme to enable electronic transaction between suppliers and the participating departments in respect of departmental purchases of non-construction related goods and services up to \$1.43 million. These participating departments include the Environmental Protection Department, the Immigration Department, and the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer.

## **Rollout Schedule for Pilot Departments**

The e-Procurement System will be rolled out progressively among the 3 pilot B/Ds, starting with the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer from 30 September 2009, followed by the Environmental Protection Department and the Immigration Department.


Quick Update – You can update your company information and product catalogue anytime, anywhere.
